"Our mission is to raise money for scholarships to be given to current seniors at Kenmore West High School (KWHS) while providing a way for KWHS alumni to learn about class reunions and other events."

The foundation was established approximately 32 years ago. It is my honor to serve as the current President of the Kenmore West Alumni Foundation (KWAf). I preside over the meetings of the foundation members and we award scholarships to students from the applicants received each year. Based on available funds, we award four to six 4-year scholarships to colleges and universities, and three 2-year scholarships to community or technical institutions. With the \$69,000 dollars awarded at our meeting in May, the KWAf is now closing in on giving a million dollars

in scholarships. This has helped approximately 250 students. We appreciate your generosity and thank you for your continued financial support.

KENMORE WEST '67, '68, '69 FOOTBALL TEAMS HONORED

On November 11, 2025 the 1967-69 Kenmore West High School football teams were honored as the 2025 Team of Distinction by the Greater Buffalo Sports Hall of Fame. Jules Yakapovich, who was inducted into the Greater Buffalo Sports Hall of Fame in 2008, was the head coach. The teams had a combined 23-1 record during the 1967-1969 seasons in which they won three Niagara Frontier Leagues, was named the #1 school in NY State and was named a "High School National Champion" by the Junior Super Bowl following a #1 ranking in the nation.
